# ATTENDANCE INFORMATION

Florida Statute 1003.24 states that each parent of a child of compulsory school age shall be responsible for each child's school attendance as required by law. The absence of a student from school is prima facie evidence of a violation of this section. Florida statute 1003.27(7)(1) states that a parent who refuses or fails to have a minor student who is under his/her control attend school regularly shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable by law.

### Truancy

A student who has (5) unexcused absences within a calendar month, or ten (10) unexcused absences within a 90- calendar-day period would be considered a truant student.

## Providing an Absence Excuse

The preferred communication method is to email the school or to provide a note with your child for the reason of the absence.

#### **Excused Absences**

Any child who is absent from school must present a written excuse signed by the parent or guardian immediately upon his/her return. The note must clearly indicate the reason for absence and must be presented within three (3) school days from the child's return to school. Please note that a phone call does not excuse your child's absence. An email will be accepted if it is submitted within three days of the absence.
