
Kanzi Apple

- Kanzi apples have a crunchy bite and deliciously wellbalanced sweet and sour flavor that derives from the unique blend of a juicy Gala sort and a tangy, sweet Braeburn sort.
- Kanzi apples have a firm, hardy nature, allowing them to be exported and shipped long distances, and the trees are somewhat drought-tolerant and vigorous.
- These apples are harvested in the late fall and kept in professional cold storage through the spring. The variety is grown in both the Northern and Southern Hemisphere, also contributing to year-round availability in some markets.
- When in season, the fruits can be eaten directly off the tree and last for extended periods, increasing the variety's popularity in retail markets worldwide.
