Parents and Guardians,

Per Florida Statute 1003.22, all incoming 7th grade students must have an updated immunization certificate (DH 680 Form) with the Tdap vaccine on file with the school prior to the start of school on August 15, 2022. If your child does not meet school health entry requirements, he/she will be excluded from school until the required immunizations and documentation have been submitted to the school.

The district has partnered with the Florida Department of Health – Duval and Health Hero Florida to offer a no-cost Tdap vaccine on Saturday, August 13th from 8 – 11 AM, at the following locations:

Jean Ribault Middle School – Media Center

Kernan Middle School - Cafeteria

Westside Middle School - Cafeteria

A parent or guardian must be present in order for the student to be vaccinated
