GUIDELINES FOR COMPLETING THE CANCELLATION FORM

Cancellation forms for any choice assignment (magnet, special transfer, charter, Title 1/NCLB or OSP) shall require the following steps listed below. To lessen the disruption to the educational process, all in-district transfer requests will occur at the end of the nine-week grading period, except for approved hardship cases.

- 1. Parent must complete the Cancellation FORM. Forms are available at any school site or can be downloaded from the Choice website www.duvalschools.org/enroll.
- 2. The parent/guardian must notify the current school of the cancellation request and receive a signature from the principal or designee.
- 3. All cancellation requests should be submitted to the Office of School Choice via email or delivered in person.
- 4. The Office of School Choice will review and process the request.
- 5. School Choice staff will notify the receiving principal.
- 6. If approved, the parent will be notified and be responsible for returning all textbooks and/or library books that were issued to the student before the student can enroll.
- 7. If both principals do not consent, the request will be sent to the Region Superintendent for review. The Region Superintendent will render a decision and the parent will be notified by the Office of School Choice.
- 8. Charter Statute 10023.33 includes a special provision that allows charter students to return to the traditional school setting which may include but is not limited to choice assignments or the neighborhood school. When a choice assignment is not available, charter students will be allowed to return to their Attendance Area School.
- 9. Cancellation requests submitted due to a change of residence whereby transportation to and from the choice school has become a hardship, will be accommodated in most cases. Parents must provide proof of residency with supporting documentation.
