## Article II: Purpose

# Article III: Membership

## Section 2 The Chairperson

#### **Article VIE Connittees**

The SAC may create such committees as necessary to carry on the work of the council.

## **Article VIII: Meetings**

Section 1. The SAC shall neet as often as necessary to perform its duties, but no less than \*\*four times per year: The first neeting shall be held no later than September: \*\*Meetings must be scheduled when parents, students, teachers, education support personnel and community members can attend \*\*All meetings shall be open to the public.

\*\*Section 2 A quarum must be present to conduct business. A majority of the membership shall constitute a quarum

\*\*Section 3 Three days written notice will be given to members concerning any item that will be voted on at the upcoming meeting

## Article IX Amendments to Bylavs

Section 1. These bylavs shall be amended at any regular meeting of the SAC by a majority of the membership

Section 2 The amendment shall become effective immediately upon passage.

## Article X: Ratification of Bylavs

The bylavs of the SAC will be ratified by a majority of if its members.

## Article XI: Parliamentary Authority

Section 1. The rules contained in the current edition of 'Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised' shall govern the association in all cases in which they are applicable and in which they do not conflict with these bylaws.

Section 2 The chairperson has the option to appoint a member of SAC as a parliamentarian at any meeting deemed necessary.
